



## 2021 Solo & Ensemble Registration Form

Students have the option to prepare and perform either a solo (one student, with an accompaniment), or a small ensemble (duet, trio, quartet, etc) for a rating at GMEA Solo & Ensemble. This is a very important learning experience for the individual student because he/she perfects selections on his/her own, and comments from the judge are directed specifically to the individual. The directors will be available to help each student before school at checkpoints in the fall. Students may participate in no more than three performances.
